

Ayew set for Hertha Berlin trials

Ghana under-20 captain Andre Dede Ayew is set to have trials with German Bundesliga side Hertha Berlin.

The 19-year-old has been told he is surplus to requirements at French giants Olympique Marseille after six years at the club.

The Berlin side has been given the opportunity to revive his career in Germany but first he must impress the coaches at the club.

Hertha Berlin's Swiss coach Lucien Favre is said to be keen on the son of Ghana legend Abedi Pele because he watched one of his matches in Ligue 1 last season.

Marseille coach Didier Deschamps excluded Dede from his pre-season team, urging the youngster to look for opportunities elsewhere.

Ayew, who is currently in France, is expected to travel to Germany for the trials.

He was sent on loan to Lorient last season.
